

A Global or Local Meal?

With the help of an adult look through your cupboards at home. Choose some of the items you have found and create an idea for a meal.

List the items for your meal in your Enrichment book. (You do not need to cook the meal.)

Cut out the world map below and glue it carefully into your book.

If you need it, there is also a UK map you can cut out and glue in.

Using your list, identify the origin of each item and label this on your world map.

(You could take photos of each item to glue into your book.)

Challenges:

- 1. First, calculate the distance each item travelled to your home.
- 2. Next, calculate the total distance for your meal.
- 3. Write a summary to explain your findings.

Extension:

In line with the Sustainable Development Goals, can you reduce your carbon footprint by sourcing the items closer to your home by either finding a source from a local farm shop or local market?

Recalculate the distance travelled for your meal and compare it to your original and then summarise your findings in a small paragraph.
